A small team of 5 went to Hamilton for the Nationals with everyone from Randwick bringing home medals: Eddie Hawkins Men's master recurve gold, Dave Velleman gold in both Clout and Field Men's recurve. Niely took the gold in Field for barebow. Peter Emmanual, our NZ Rep, achieving 2 silvers in Men's target and is officially the Number 2 archer in NZ. Neville Clark picked up medals in Teams and in Masters Compound.

Im sure I have missed a few but all in all our archers have all over the country made our club proud. We at Randwick are all prod of anyone that has competed for Randwick. Clout WAA was won by Allan and Liz Atkinson. 600 shoots have gone well and our club members have had some excellent results.
