



RULES OF RANDWICK ARCHERY CLUB INCORPORATED



SEPTEMBER 27, 2020

NAME

The name of the society—referred to as the Club—is Randwick Archery Club Incorporated.

PURPOSES

The Purposes of the Club are to support and foster recreational and competitive archery.

BECOMING MEMBERS

To become Members of the Club prospective members must be approved by a Coach of the Club, complete and submit a membership form, be approved by the Committee, and pay the appropriate subscription.

CEASING TO BE MEMBERS

Members cease to be Members if they resign, fail to renew their membership, die, or if their membership is terminated.

GENERAL MEETINGS

The Committee must call an Annual General Meeting annually and may call a Special General Meeting at any time. They must call a Special General Meeting if called on to do so by a minimum of twelve members.

The Committee must give Members at least four weeks' Notice of a General Meeting.

A General Meeting can be held even if some Members do not receive Notice but cannot be held without a quorum of twelve Members.

Motions put to a General Meeting are decided by a simple majority of votes cast. Each Member present is entitled to a single vote. In the event of a tie, the Chair has a casting vote.

COMMITTEE

The Committee consists of five Officers—President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Field Captain—and up to five general Committee Members.

Committee Members are elected at Annual General Meetings and serve until the following Annual General Meeting. Vacancies can be filled by resolution of the Committee.

COMMON SEAL

The Secretary is the custodian of the Club's Common Seal.

The Seal may be affixed to any document by resolution of the Committee. The sealed document must be signed by the President and countersigned by another Committee Member.

FUNDS

The Club's Funds are controlled by the Committee.

The Funds can be invested by resolution of the Committee.

Additional Funds can be borrowed by resolution of a General Meeting.

LIQUIDATION

The Club can be liquidated by resolution of a General Meeting confirmed by resolution of a second General Meeting held at least one month later.

Surplus assets will be divided equally between Members who have been Members for at least the last three years prior to the date of liquidation.

The Committee can make and update Bylaws by resolution.
